*Car & Light Truck tires . . . . . \$4.00 each*  
*Truck Tires . . . . . \$12.00 each*  
*Tractor Tires . . . . . \$15.00 each*  
*All tires on rims add \$2.00 more*

Pick up trucks are permitted but there will be a minimum charge of \$20.00 after (1) load. Pick-ups with trailer and other large loads are charged at the discretion of the Road Foreman.

### DO NOT BRING:

Recyclables, Construction Materials, Household Garbage, Paint Cans, Hazardous Chemicals, Sealed or Open Containers of Solvents, Paint Thinners. No newspaper or yard clippings or residue from burning barrels.
